

WORK & LEARN

EDUCATION PARTNER SCHOLARSHIP

The Work & Learn Education Partner Scholarship is designed to assist student-employees of an approved Work & Learn employer with a passion for culinary arts.

APPLICABILITY

The scholarship applies to all courses and programs outlined in the Boulder Student Programs Catalog and the Austin Students Program Catalog at the Auguste Escoffier School of Culinary Arts.

MONETARY AWARD

The scholarship provides a student \$1,000 - \$5,250 toward direct tuition over the course of the program.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To qualify for this scholarship, candidates must:

1. Be enrolled as an active student attending the Auguste Escoffier School of Culinary Arts in Boulder, Colorado, or Austin, Texas
2. Be currently employed by an approved Work & Learn employer
3. Remain an eligible student

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Candidates must provide a current pay stub with an approved Work & Learn employer as proof of employment.

To be eligible for the maximum scholarship benefit, submission of a pay stub must be made within the first 6-week session of enrollment and at the beginning of each academic year you remain in the program.

EMPLOYMENT STATUS

Both full-time and part-time employees of an approved Work & Learn employer are eligible.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION

NEW ENROLLEES: Documentation must be submitted within the first 6 weeks of the program.

CURRENT STUDENTS: Late submissions may result in a reduced scholarship award.

CITIZENSHIP

The scholarship is open to U.S. and international students of Auguste Escoffier School of Culinary Arts.

SCHOLARSHIP AND DISBURSEMENT

The total scholarship award is applied over the length of the full program and is contingent on the following items:

1. When the student submits valid proof of qualified employment
2. Must have an approved tuition funding plan with Financial Aid
3. Meeting financial obligations to the school
4. The employer partner contract dates between your employer and the Auguste Escoffier School of Culinary Arts align with the student's submission for scholarship benefits

If the student transfers to a different AESCA program after any award amount has been distributed, the remaining award amount may be transferred to the new program upon request.
